## **Recent Beef Issues**

The School Dinner Company have asked us to pass on the following: In view of the recent issues concerning beef products, we have been in touch with our two meat suppliers and they have confirmed that all the meat they supply to us is fully traceable and the beef they purchase is UK reared and supplied by local farms.

## Measles

The Health Protection Agency has asked us to pass on the following information: Following a significant rise in measles cases in the Gloucestershire area, which has led to a number of children and adults being hospitalised, health professionals are asking parents and adults (specifically those born after 1988, after the introduction of the MMR vaccination, who may have missed out on MMR as a child) to check their Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) vaccination history to ensure they and their children have received the required two doses of MMR. **Signs and Symptoms:** Measles is an infectious viral illness that is spread by droplets in the air when infected people cough or sneeze. The following symptoms are commonly seen in measles infection: Fever, Cough, Sore and watering eyes and widespread rash that develops 3-4 days after the onset of the illness, starting with the face and head and spreading down the body.
