Year 2's next topic is 'Coast to Coast.' We will be basing our topic around islands and the seaside. This topic is cross curricular so our Art, D&T, Geography and History will all be linked to this.

In English we will look at stories, recounts, postcards and letters.

In Maths we will be covering time, measurement, position and direction and place value.

In Science we will learn about plants and animals including humans.

In RE we will be learning about Christianity and Judaism. We will be listening to religious stories and learning about special objects people of faith use to help them worship. There will also to be RE days relating to different aspects of religions.

Children are expected to read each day and now that the children are involved in the Accelerated Reading programme they have the opportunity to show understanding though the completion of quizzes. We continue to encourage children to read as much as possible because through reading the children broaden their vocabulary to use within their writing.

The children have loved our Space topic and I hope that the children are looking forward to the next topic. They have a very busy term ahead of them including the SATs, these really are not something that they need to feel worried about and we have had lots of practise and they have actually enjoyed the assessments we have done so far. Spellings will be sent out in the first week for the entire term and tested each Friday. Please also keep working with your child so that they consolidate the 2, 5 and 10 times tables confidently and begin to learn the 3 and 4 x tables.

Our PE days will now be Tuesday and Thursday. Hopefully, we will have some good weather so children will need shorts, a t-shirt, a jumper and trainers. This coming term we will be

looking at striking and fielding skills, athletics and
fundamental movement skills.
