

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Aims

The national curriculum for physical education aims to ensure that all pupils:

- develop competence to excel in a broad range of physical activities
 - are physically active for sustained periods of time
 - engage in competitive sports and activities
 - lead healthy, active lives.

At Grangefield, we teach PE as a discrete subject and the scheme of work follows a developmental process – **Learn to Move, Move to Learn**. It is split into 4 sections:

EYFS Multi skills

KS1 Fundamental Movement Skills & games

LKS2 Transferable skills & basic tactics

UKS2 Application to games with tactics

The children are able to experience a range of sports and activities which work on enabling them to improve their skills and gain a greater understanding of the importance behind being healthy. Games, Outdoor Adventure Activities, Gymnastics, Dance and Swimming are all covered within this developmental process.

We are an active school within our local community and are part of the local school sport cluster. This provides us with the opportunity to take children to the Secondary School and take part in activities such as Kinball, mini Olympics and cross country.

We are also very active within the wider Cheltenham network and enter teams into the Netball and Football Leagues. We take part in county run rounders competitions, Quad Kids, Athletics to name just a few.

We pride ourselves on our sportsmanship and this underpins all our values when it comes to sport – even though we are competitive too.

We hold competition within school too, using our owl groups to compete against each other. We hold an intra cross country competition where the children were competing in their owl groups running around the school grounds and the local park.
