Year 2's next topic is 'Out of this World.' We will be basing our topic around Space. This topic is cross curricular so our Art, D&T, Music and some PE will all be linked to these.

In English we will look at narrative stories, poetry, newspaper reports and letters.

In Maths we will be covering multiplication and division, money, properties of shape and fractions.

In Science we will learn about materials and Space, eventually making a space suit. We will be making moon buggies in DT to include moving parts in model.

In RE we will be about Christianity and what it means to belong. There will also to be RE days relating to different aspects of religions.

Our homework will be as last term. The children will receive a combination of SPaG, Maths and please continue with the 'Make the World a better place' activities. They are also expected to read each day. I encourage children to read as much as possible because through reading the children broaden their vocabulary to use within their writing.

I hope that the children are looking forward to the next topic and they have a very busy term ahead of them. Spellings will be sent out in the first week for the entire term and tested each Friday.
