Dear Year 2 Parents,

Year 2's next topic is 'Land, Sea and Air.' We will be basing our topic around Explorers and Space. This topic is cross curricular so our Art, D&T, Music and some PE will all be linked to these.

In English we will look at narrative stories, poetry and recounts.

In Maths we will be covering multiplication and division, properties of shape and fractions.

In Science we will learn about materials and Space, eventually making a space suit. We will be making moon buggies in DT to include moving parts in model.

Our homework will be as last term. The children will receive a combination of SPaG and Maths. This will be sent out on a Monday to be handed in the following Monday. They are also expected to read each day and then quiz at school the following morning. We will be monitoring this closely over the term so please do read with your children each night if this is possible. We encourage children to read as much as possible because through reading the children broaden their vocabulary to use within their writing.

I hope that the children are looking forward to the next topic and they have a very busy term ahead of them. Spellings will be sent out in the second week we are back and will be tested on the following Tuesday. Please also keep working with your child so that they can learn the 2, 5 and 10 times tables confidently.

Our PE days will still be Tuesday and Thursday and they will need a full PE kit including jogging bottoms and jumper for outside PE as well as shorts and t-shirt for indoor PE. This coming term we will be looking at dance and fundamental movement skills linked to net games. We have entered the children in to the Feet First dance festival so our dance will be performed at the Town Hall, details of this will follow.
