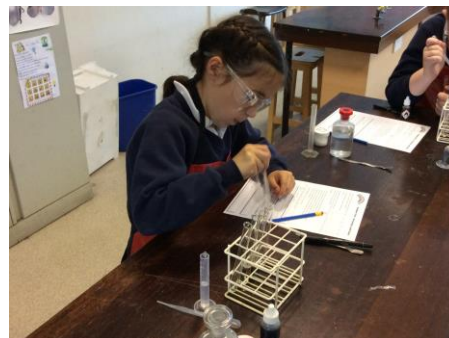
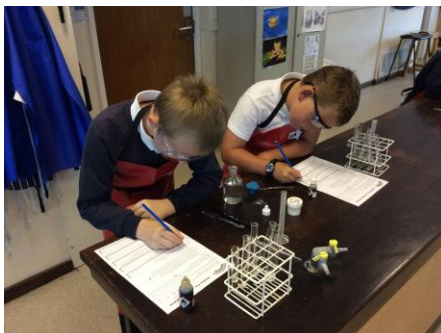
Y4 Chedworth Roman Villa by Bailey and Charlie St
