**COVID19**

Due to needing the increased ventilation in the school as per the COVID guidelines in place and with the weather turning cooler please ensure that children have their school jumpers or cardigans with them.

- If your child has a temperature, new continuous cough or has lost their sense of smell or taste then you will need to get a covid test. If the test is positive the child needs to stay home for at least 10 days and until the temperature has gone.
- If you are awaiting the results of a COVID test for any member of your household please inform the school office as soon as your test results come back to you.
- If a child shows any COVID-19 symptoms they cannot return to school without receiving a negative test.
- Many thanks to you for wearing a face covering at drop off and pick up. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated. We are conscious that because of numbers it is not always possible to keep a social distance at all times so it is really important that we counter this by using face coverings.
- Please remember to stick to the timings below and drop off your child as quickly as possible. Try to avoid coming earlier than your allocated time. If you do have children in multiple year groups please drop them all off at the same time (the earliest relevant slot). For example if you have a child in Year 3 and Year 5 you can drop them both off at 8:45am. You will then collect them at the latest relevant time slot.

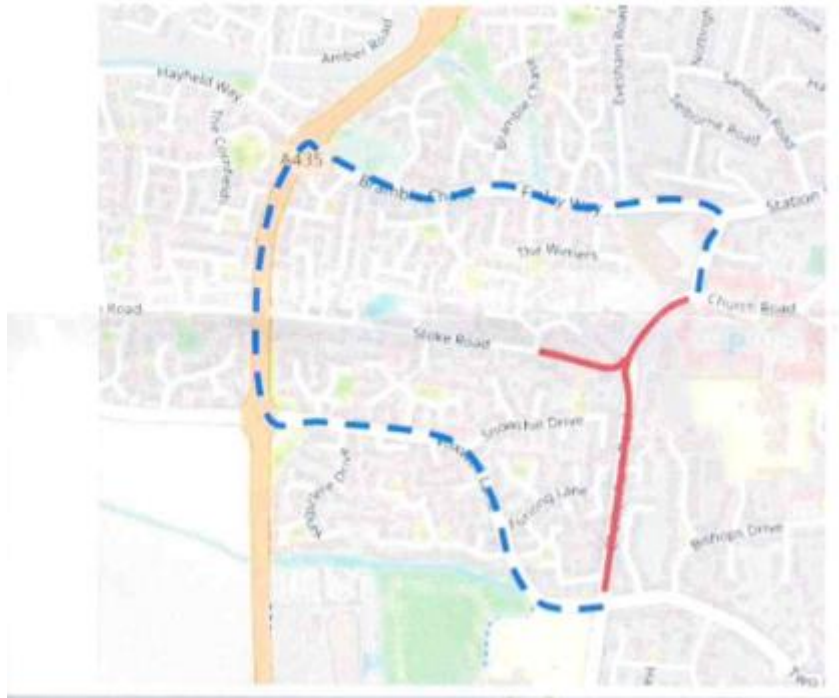
