COVID19 Catch Up

Just a reminder... If your child is attending school and has any of the following symptoms please keep your child off school and at home. You will need to get a test for your child.

- A new continuous cough
- A high temperature
- A complete loss or change of smell or taste

If your child develops symptoms of COVID-19, they must not come to school and should remain at home for at least 10 days from the date when their symptoms appeared. Anyone with symptoms will be eligible for testing and this can be arranged via <https://www.nhs.uk/ask-for-a-coronavirus-test> or by calling 119. All other household members who remain well, must stay at home and not leave the house for 14 days. This includes anyone in your 'Support Bubble'.

- Whether you are coming into school or learning from home If your child or anyone in your household has a COVID test please let the school know (admin@grangefield.gloucs.sch.uk) or 01242 671003.
