Well done to all the children and thanks to the parents who came to support.

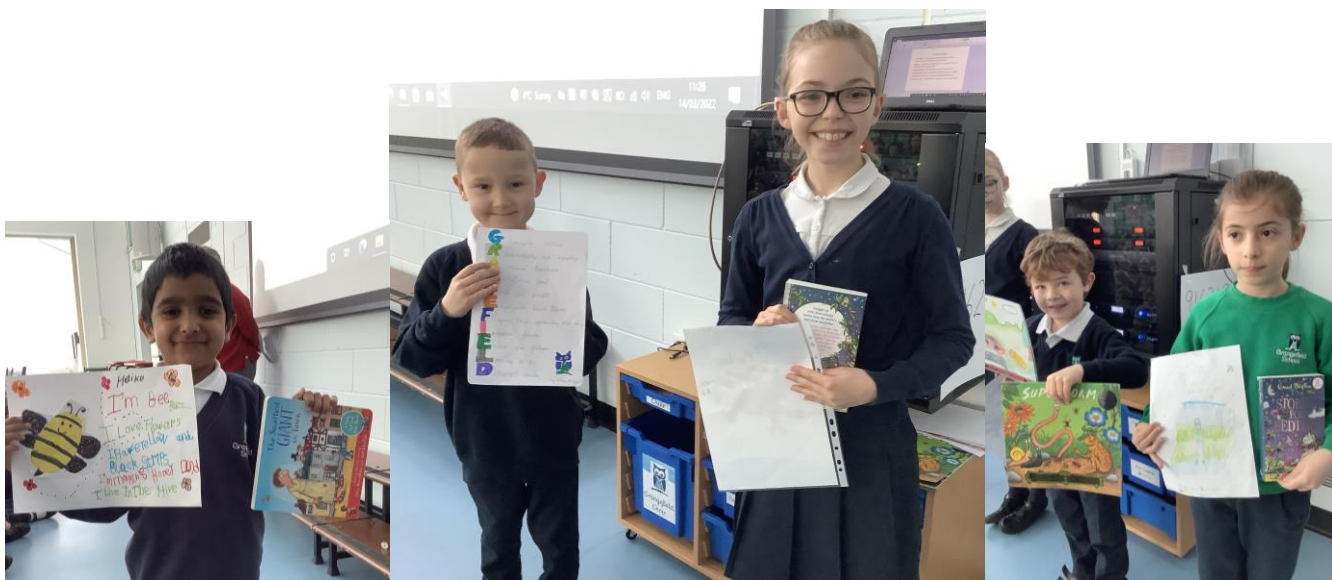
Tree Planting – Grange Field


