### Parking



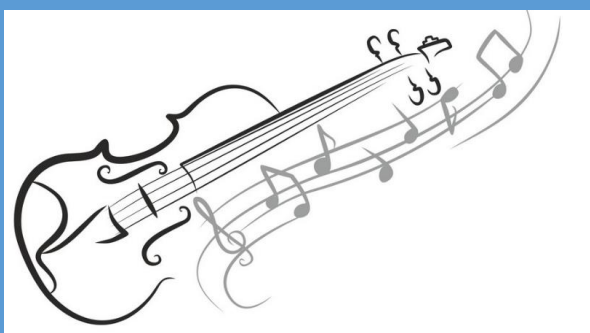
