| Our response: | 93.4% of parents agreed with this with 6.6% disagreeing. Parent Consultations are held twice a year. This gives parents a planned opportunity to liaise with their child's class teacher to discuss progress, attainment, targets for improvement and a full written report is sent home at the end of the school year.
