At your Parents Evening appointment, you will be given a Data Collection sheet for your child, please make any changes and return to the school office.

Staff Car Park

We are still seeing parent cars entering the car park when permission has not been given to them. Parents **MUST NOT** drive into the car park at any time of the day, for any reason, unless you have spoken to the school office team and you have been granted permission to do so.

Also, please stick to the paths, where possible, when entering the school, especially when dropping off at Little Hoots, when the cars are arriving.

Illnesses

We have a number of tummy bugs circulating around school, so as a reminder; children should remain absent from school for 48 hours following the last occurrence of sickness and / or diarrhoea.

Signing In System

We have had a new signing in system installed in the school office. It is currently being used for staff and visitors. We are slowly implementing pupils, so from now on, parents will be asked to use the system for the following:

- to sign children out, if they are leaving the school grounds during school hours
- to sign children in, if they are entering the school grounds following an appointment

Following the Easter Holidays, parents will be asked to sign children in, if they are late to school for any reason and have to enter the school through the main doors rather than the gates.

Road Safety around the School Grounds

Please park carefully and drive slowly when parking near the school. Children should be supervised when they leave the school grounds. Please avoid leaving your engine running when you are waiting outside the school grounds. If you need to park in neighbouring streets, please be mindful not to block driveways or obstruct the pavements.

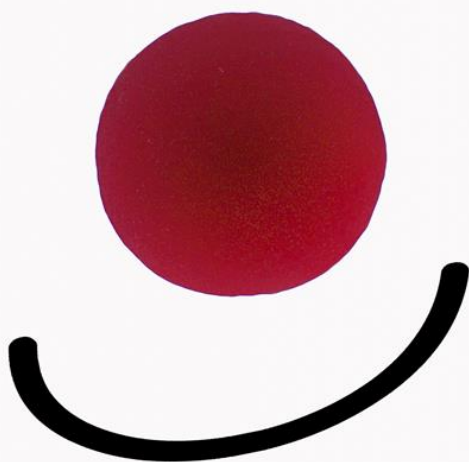

Our third game was against Swindon Village A, where we were also unfortunate to lose 5-0. The score did not reflect the game as the girls played fantastically and had numerous shots on target.

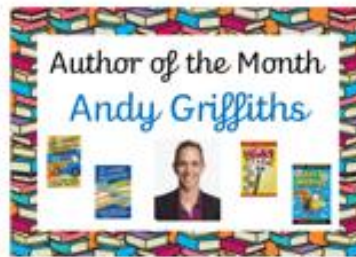
Our fourth and final game was against Swindon Village B, where we won 5-0, saving the best game till last! (Goal scorers – Lola x3, Chloe x2)

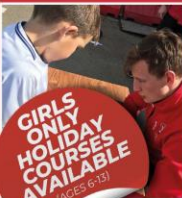
