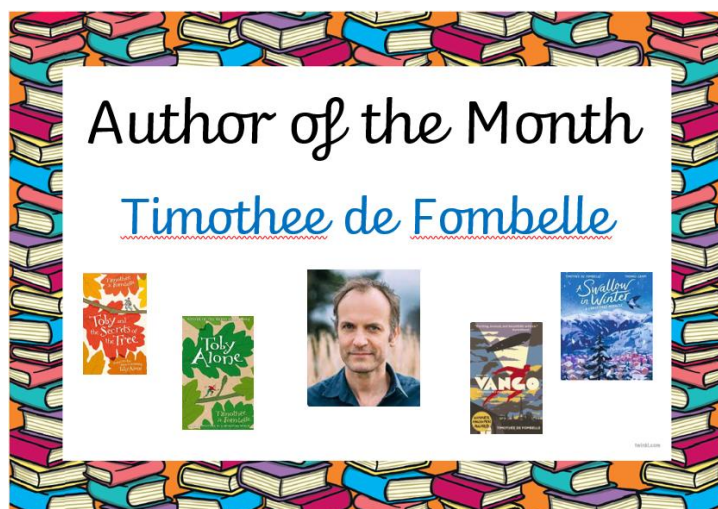
Orders are dispatched within 2 working days of the fair ending so never long to wait!

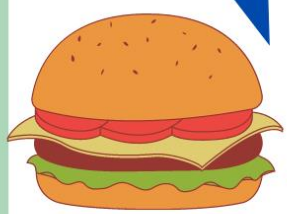
