School Dinners

Key Stage 2 parents – please make sure you pay your dinner money regularly. We are no longer able to let the total debt go beyond £10 and if this does happen you will need to bring in a packed lunch for your child until the debt is paid. Road Safety around the School Grounds

Please park carefully and drive slowly when parking near the school. Children should be supervised when they leave the school grounds. Please do not leave your engine running when you are waiting outside the school grounds. If you need to park in neighbouring streets, please be mindful not to block driveways or obstruct the pavements. Please do not drive into the staff car park, unless you have been given permission, at any time of the day.

Please do not walk across the car park when entering or leaving school or Little Hoots. Cars are still entering and exiting the car park during the start and end of the school day.

Uniform

A reminder that the correct uniform should be worn to school, details of which can be found on our uniform policy on the website. Earrings should be small stud earrings and removed or covered for PE. Smart Watches with cameras should not be worn at school.

Important - Year Six transition to Secondary School

You should have receive a letter via your child with details of the transition. You must make your application electronically by no later than the date on the letter. This is extremely important as any applications received after this date may not be considered until after March 2024. Please do look at secondary school websites for schools you are interested in your child attending after Grangefield in order to find out when their open session days are.
